



Beaver Dam Raceway is proud to announce for 2019' "Modified Shootout". Powered by The Dump Bar & Grill. This \$5000 purse, \$1000 to win and \$100 to start invitational event to be held at Beaver Dam Raceway August 10th, 2019 (rain date August 17th, 2019). In addition that night one lucky fan will also have the chance to win \$500.

RACE DETAILS

- This race will consist of 25 laps and pay no less than \$100 to start and \$1000 to win.
- There are no additional entry fees or other costs over and above the weekly pit pass fee associated with participating in the "Modified Shootout Powered by The Dump Bar & Grill".
- There will be 22 starting spots up for grabs.
- In order to qualify for this event each car must display the "Shootout" sponsor sticker on the fan side of the car either on the sail panel or upper half of the rear quarter panel for the entire 2019' racing season.
- Any Modified driver winning a heat race during any of the 6 division nights leading up to the "Shootout" will become eligible for the "Shootout". Any driver winning a heat race and not displaying the "Modified Shootout Powered by The Dump Bar & Grill" sponsor sticker will forfeit their eligibility for that heat race win.
- Should a driver be disqualified due to an infraction the driver that is awarded the win becomes qualified providing that he/she has meet all other requirements.
- With the possibility that more than 22 drivers becoming eligible for the "Shootout" the 22 available starting spots will be awarded bases on total heat race wins.
- In the event of a tie the driver with the highest point standing for the 2019' Beaver Dam Raceway season prior to the event will be awarded the starting position.
- In the event that less than 22 drivers become eligible for the "Shootout" Beaver Dam Raceway reserves the right to add to the starting field any driver that has either won an A-main or B-main during the 6 division nights leading up to the "Shootout". If for some reason the starting field of 22 cars has still not been met additional cars may be added to the starting field based on their 2019' Beaver Dam Raceway season point standings.

- The starting lineup for the "Modified Shootout Powered by The Dump Bar & Grill" will be determined by a series of two qualifying races the night of the "Shootout". The driver with the most heat race wins will start on the pole of the 1st qualifying race. The driver with the second most heat race wins will start on the pole of the 2nd qualifying race and so on. The order of finish of the qualifying races will be used to determine the starting lineup for the "Shootout". Winning driver of qualifying race #1 will start on the pole. The winning driver of qualifying race #2 will start outside front row and so on.
- The "Modified Shootout Powered by The Dump Bar & Grill" will be the last scheduled race of the night. Eligible Modifieds will ONLY run the "Shootout" on this night. This is a non-points night for the Modifieds and will not reflect on 2019' Beaver Dam Raceway points.
- All cars participating in the "Shootout" will be inspected prior to the on track introductions.
- The "Shootout" will be governed by Beaver Dam Raceway Modified rules posted for the 2019' racing season.
- Every fan (21 or older) with paid admission to the grandstands at Beaver Dam Raceway the night of the "Shootout" will receive 1 free raffle ticket. In addition fans will have the opportunity to purchase additional tickets (these tickets will be of a different color than the free ones) for \$1 each in an effort to increase their chances in the drawing. All money raised from these additional ticket sales will be donated to Beaver Dam Police Department Charities, 501(c)(3) non-profit #15309-800.
- One lucky fan will win \$500 by selecting the winning driver of the "Shootout" only if the winning driver draws his/her ticket.
- All qualified drivers will have a bucket with his/her car number on it near concessions. Fans will select which driver they feel has the best chance to win the "Shootout" and place their ticket in the corresponding bucket. All buckets will be closed at the end of intermission.
- The winning driver will be given his/her bucket and draw a ticket. Once the winning ticket holder is verified by track management that winning ticket holder will be escorted to victory lane for photos with the winning driver. A 5 minute window will be given for the ticket to be claimed. Should that ticket not be claimed within the 5 minute allotted time a new ticket will then be drawn.
- In the event that the winning driver has no tickets in his/her bucket this \$500 will also be donated to Beaver Dam Police Department Charities, 501(c)(3) non-profit #15309-800.
